We wish you all a warm welcome back from the Breakfast and After School Club. The Breakfast Club provision will continue to provide a healthy selection of breakfasts from 7:45 a.m.



We try to cater for all likes and dislikes and also encourage the children to try new foods. Please ensure you have completed an Allergen form for your child and returned it to the school office.

We also provide a range of games and activities for the club but like to encourage a gentle, caring start to the school day. The older children provide 'buddy' support in a family type atmosphere in keeping with the school's philosophy with an emphasis on good manners.



We look forward to any new breakfast clubbers. You can just turn up anytime from 8:00 a.m. although it is helpful to pre book so that we can welcome any new faces. If you do require Breakfast Club Provision from 7:45 a.m. please can we ask that the office staff are made aware. All parents/carers MUST sign their child/children into the Before School Club on admission to the hall.

To ensure the safety of the children in the Before School Club please can we ask that only the children in the breakfast club use the Adventure Playground before school. Many thanks.

Our Before School Club will continue to run from 7:45 a.m. each day, if booked in advance, at a cost of £5.00, this includes breakfast.

8:00 – 8:30 a.m. - £3.00 which includes breakfast or £1.50 if you arrive after 8:30 and do not require a breakfast.

We look forward to welcoming your child into Breakfast Club.

MUSIC LESSONS

Fees for music lessons are now due. The cost is £35 per term for each instrument, this can be paid in two equal halves if you wish. Cheques should be made payable to East Riding of Yorkshire Council, thank you.



PE KITS

Please can we ask all parents to ensure that pupils have their full PE kits in school on a **Monday**.

PE lessons will continue to be taught on a **Tuesday** and a **Thursday**. Some lessons will take place outside and therefore the pupils will require warm clothing e.g. tracksuit, jogging bottoms, hoody/sweatshirt. Further to this they will also require trainers with a good grip.



An indoor PE Kit should comprise of a short sleeved white t-shirt and a pair of black/navy/white shorts and plimsolls. Thank you. **If your child does not have the appropriate footwear for PE lessons, then we will have no alternative but to exclude them from the lesson due to health and safety precautions.**
