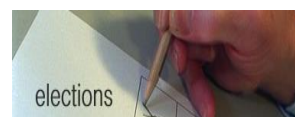


GENERAL ELECTIONS


AFTER SCHOOL GOLF COACHING

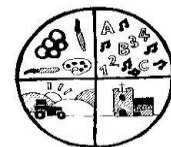
