PARKING OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL

During a recent governing body meeting the issue of parking outside of the school was discussed, with a particular focus on parking on the grass verges inside of the double yellow lines.



Following the meeting, the vice chair of governors contacted the Highways department to gain further clarification. Please see the response below.

Double Yellow Lines cover the entire public highway from boundary to boundary. This will include road / verges and footpaths. We enforce across all, so people parking on the grass verge would be at risk of obtaining a ticket. Zig-Zags are there for obvious safety reasons and people should simply not park on them, where the Zig-Zags are mandatory, as at Garton on the Wolds, our civil enforcement officers will serve a Penalty Charge Notice on anyone found to be contravening them.

As you are aware the school takes the health and safety of our pupils and parents seriously, for this reason please could we ask that parents parking outside of the school ensure they adhere to the parking restrictions. Thank you for your support.

LIFESTYLE 2017

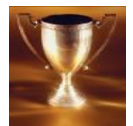
