Year 6 SATS Week

Our Year 6 children will be completing their SATS tests during the week commencing 12th May.

The entire year group has been preparing, demonstrating an impressive level of commitment and hard work. We are immensely proud of the progress each child has made and we have every confidence in their ability to achieve their personal best during these assessments.

The timetable for the SATS tests is as follows:

- Monday 12th May – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling
- Tuesday 13th May – Reading
- Wednesday 14th May – Maths Paper 1 and 2
- Thursday 15th May – Maths Paper 3

It is crucial that Year 6 children are present in school on these days, as each test plays an important role in assessing their progress and understanding of the curriculum. We will receive the results in July 2025, which will be shared promptly with parents and carers so everyone can celebrate the accomplishments of our children.

As the term advances, I would also like to inform you that our Year 1 children will be participating in the Phonics Screening Check and Year 4 children will complete a multiplication check.

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Seesaw

We will continue to use the Seesaw app for parents to contact class teachers. Any enquiries related to your child's learning or general queries about the class (i.e. PE Days, reading books) should be sent through Seesaw.

Any general school queries (school dinners, school events) should be directed to the school office, via e-mail or phone. Class teachers are normally on the playground at the start/end of the school day as well.

School Dinners

Dinner menus are available on our school website under Parents > School Dinners.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the 'Universal Infant Free School Meal' Government initiative. Alternatively, parents are permitted to send their child with a packed lunch, if they wish.

For children in Nursery, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 – hot dinners will be available each day at a cost of **£2.65** per day or £13.25 per week. Payment for dinners can be made using the Parent Pay app.

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Breakfast Club and After-School Club

Both Breakfast Club and After-School Club continue to be available during term time.

Breakfast Club is available from 7:45am until 8:55am.

- From 7:45am (including breakfast) £5.00
- From 8:00am (including breakfast) £3.00
- From 8:30am (excluding breakfast) £2.00

After-School Club is available from 3:30pm until 5:00pm.

- 3:30pm – 4:00pm £2.00
- 3:30pm – 4:30pm £3.00
- 3:30pm – 5:00pm £5.00

Please ensure you have completed the booking form prior to your child attending the clubs or you have made contact with the School Office to arrange a booking.
