Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you of an exciting educational visit for our Class 2 and Class 3 pupils, which is scheduled for Friday, 16th May. We will be visiting Burton Constable Hall, where the focus of the day will be on science, specifically exploring the fascinating world of plants.

During our visit, both classes will engage with a Parkland officer, who will educate the children about plants, wildlife, and conservation. Class 2 will also have the opportunity to explore Toys from the Past, linking directly to their current topic, while Class 3 will explore a World War II exhibition situated within the grounds.

As this visit will take place outdoors, we kindly request that the children come prepared. They should wear comfortable clothes, including leggings/PE trousers, and sturdy walking shoes; trainers are ideal. In addition, please ensure that your child brings a waterproof coat, a packed lunch, and more than one drink to stay hydrated.

The children are encouraged to wear their school sweatshirt or cardigan for easy identification. If they wish, they may also bring £4 or £5 to purchase an ice-cream or lolly from the shop. Please make sure that any money is in a labelled envelope or wallet.

The full cost of the visit is **£6.25** per child, which includes the cost of the transport. Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution of **£6.00**, this can be paid via the Parent Pay app. The remaining balance will be met by School Funds. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the trip possible, otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made.

Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support.

Please provide consent for your child's participation for the visit via the Parent Pay app. Please note children will not be permitted to take part unless parental consent is received.
