Departure Day – Tuesday 24th

- Children need to be dropped off at York Railway Station for 9:00am. Staff will meet the children in the main entrance.
- Parents/carers are welcome to stay to wave the children off.
- Children will need a rucksack with their packed lunch in it (disposable).
- Children will need to be wearing comfortable clothing, sensible shoes and have a waterproof coat.

Departure Day – Tuesday 24th

- Any medication your child needs must be brought into school on the morning of Monday 23rd June and handed to Mrs Curtis. Please make sure there are clear, written instructions on how and when the medicine should be taken. This should include any travel sickness medication.
- If your child has asthma, please ensure you provide them with a new inhaler from home.

Departure Day – Tuesday 24th

- We will depart York Station at 9:33am.
- The train is direct to London and we will arrive at London King's Cross at approximately 11:38am.

Arriving home – Friday 27th

- We are due to depart London King's Cross at 4:00pm and will arrive back at York Station at 5:52pm.
- If there are any delays then a text message will be sent out.
- Children must be collected from the main entrance of York Station.

Accommodation



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- We will be staying at YHA London Central which is a short walk from Oxford Street.
- The hostel has over 302 rooms and various room sizes with 4 to 8 beds.
- Children will be provided with breakfast at the hostel.
- On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday the hostel will also be providing the children with a packed lunch.
- We will be eating out each evening.

Packing

- Children will be carrying/wheeling their own suitcase

Please pack lightly!

- Clothing should be comfortable.
- Please name all items of clothing.
- Children will need the following personal kit:

- Toilet requisites (soap, shampoo, toothpaste etc).
- Children with long hair may find a shower cap useful.
- Hand towel and a large towel.
- Pyjamas/nightie/slippers.
- Changes of underwear and socks.

- Layers of clothing i.e. T-shirts, sweatshirts and a waterproof coat.
- Walking shoes/trainers - you must have footwear that you can walk several miles in and that will keep your feet dry.
- Sun hat and sun cream.
- A refillable, leak-proof water bottle.

- A plastic bin liner for dirty clothes.
- A backpack is essential so children can carry their daily packed lunch in it.
- Spending money (up to £30) in small denominations in a labelled envelope with the total on the front. Please bring this in on Monday 23rd June and hand to Mrs Curtis.
- Children may also bring a small packet of sweets for each evening. They may also bring a packet to take into the theatre.

Optional equipment:

- Dressing gown
- Disposable camera or a cheap digital camera

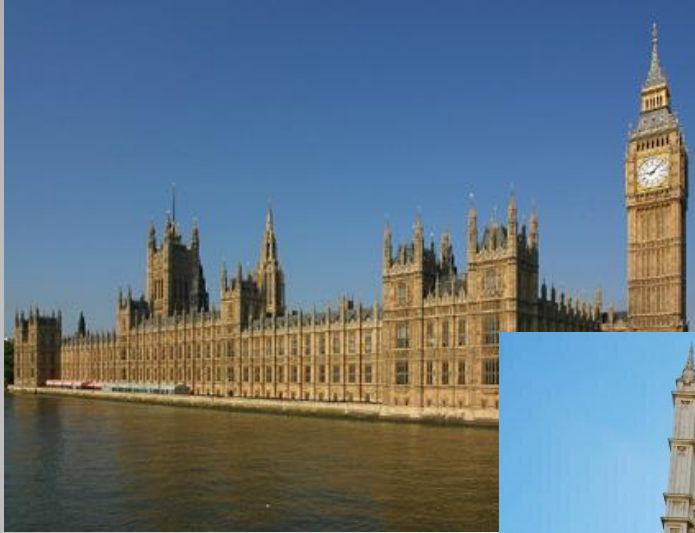
For the journey:
