Dear Parents/Carers,

CLASS 4 VISIT TO BRIDLINGTON WILDLIFE PARK

As you are aware, our Science theme for this term is Animal Life Cycles and Classification. To enhance the children's learning further, we have arranged an educational visit to the Bridlington Wildlife Park on Monday 10th November 2025, where we will meet and learn about a range of different animals. The children will also enjoy 2 educational workshops led by their Educational Officer. We shall be leaving school just after 9 a.m. and returning at 3.30 p.m. in time for the end of the school day. Your child will require a packed lunch stored in a labelled plastic bag which can then be thrown away at the park to avoid unnecessary baggage.

If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal, a school packed lunch can be ordered at no cost. If you require a school packed lunch, please ensure you inform the office staff, via telephone or e-mail by **Thursday 23rd October** at the very latest.

Your child will also require warm clothing and suitable footwear for the day as most of the activities are outside. Please can we ask that a school sweatshirt/cardigan is worn over the top of clothing to allow for easy identification.

The full cost of the visit is **£22.34** per child, which includes the cost of the transport and entrance to the zoo. Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution of **£15.00**, this can be paid via the Parent Pay app. The remaining balance will be met by School Funds. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the trip possible, otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made.

Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support.

Please provide consent for your child's participation for the visit via the Parent Pay app. Please note children will not be permitted to take part unless parental consent is received.
