CLASS 3 VISIT TO HULL & EAST YORKSHIRE MUSEUM OF ARCHAEOLOGY

For our educational visit this term we will visit the Hull and East Yorkshire Museum of Archaeology Yorkshire Museum in Hull to explore what life was like in Prehistoric Britain. Children will take part in 'a pre history workshop' to discover what it was like in the stone and bronze age. Children will also have the opportunity to explore the museum try out bow drills, quern stones and work together to create cave-inspired artwork.

The visit will take place on Wednesday 12th November 2025. We shall be leaving school just after 9 a.m. and returning at 3.30 p.m. in time for the end of the school day.

Your child will require a packed lunch stored in a labelled plastic bag which can then be thrown away to avoid unnecessary baggage. If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal a school packed lunch can be ordered at no cost. If you require a school packed lunch please ensure you inform the office staff, via telephone or e-mail by **Thursday 23rd October** at the very latest.

Please can we ask that a school sweatshirt/cardigan is worn over the top of clothing to allow for easy identification.

The full cost of the visit is **£20.98** per child, which includes the cost of the transport and entrance to the museum. Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution of **£15.00**, this can be paid via the Parent Pay app. The remaining balance will be met by School Funds. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the trip possible, otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made.

Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support.

Please provide consent for your child's participation for the visit via the Parent Pay app. Please note children will not be permitted to take part unless parental consent is received.
