Dear Parent/Carer,

Class 1 – Education Visit to Adventure Play Town

We are delighted to inform you that we have arranged an exciting school visit for our Foundation Stage children on **Wednesday 19th November 2025**. Our class will soon be visiting Adventure Playtown, a wonderful and imaginative role-play centre designed especially for young children with a magical town filled with themed play areas, the children can become fearless astronauts, daring firefighters, brilliant chefs, and much more!

This visit will provide a fantastic opportunity for the children to explore and develop key skills within the Personal, Social and Emotional Development area of the Early Years Foundation Stage framework. Through imaginative play and teamwork, children will have the opportunity to build confidence as they take on different roles and responsibilities in the play town. They will continue to develop their social skills by communicating, negotiating, and collaborating with their friends during role play. Adventure Playtown offers a safe, stimulating environment and we are sure this will be a memorable and enriching experience for all the children.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school in the morning and returning in time for the end of the school day. Please ensure your child is wearing their school uniform and they will require a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal and you wish for a packed lunch to be provided, please ensure the office is made aware by **Friday 14th November 2025** at the latest.

Consent for your child's participation for the visit is via the Parent Pay app. The full cost of the visit is **£21.66** per child, which includes the cost of the transport and admission to the venue. Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution of **£15.00**, this can be paid via the Parent Pay app. The remaining balance will be met by School Funds. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the trip possible, otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be given for any payments already made.

Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support.

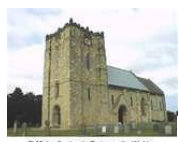
