Dear Parents and Carers,

Class 2 visit- Tophill Low Nature Reserve

We are delighted to inform you that the children in Year 1 and Year 2 will be taking part in an educational visit to Top Hill Low Nature Reserve on Thursday 4th December. The visit will take place during school hours, leaving at 9.15 am and returning before the end of the school day. This visit will complement our current learning in Science around 'Seasonal Changes' and will be led by a children's scientist. Throughout the day, the children will explore the reserve to find evidence of the autumn and winter seasons and deepen their understanding of the changes that occur between the seasons.

As much of the visit will take place outdoors, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. They will need to wear warm clothing, including jogging bottoms, a fleece, a coat and wellies. If the weather is particularly cold, gloves, warm socks and a hat will also be necessary.

Please be aware your child will require a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal and you wish for a packed lunch to be provided, please ensure the office is made aware by **Wednesday 26th November 2025** at the latest.

Consent for your child's participation for the visit is via the Parent Pay app. The full cost of the visit is **£11.90** per child, which includes the cost of the transport and admission to the venue. Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution of **£11.00**, this can be paid via the Parent Pay app. The remaining balance will be met by School Funds. The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the trip possible, otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be given for any payments already made.

Parents who are eligible for a reduction according to the school's charging and remission policy or receive free school lunches, should contact the school for further information about financial support.

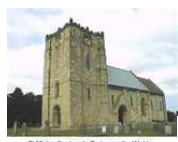
