Covid-19 Self-Isolation Guidance

As you will be aware from communication at the end of last term, the Government have made changes to Covid-19 guidance. Please see below for a reminder of the latest guidance:

- **adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature**
- **children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend**
- **adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days**

Please keep the School Office updated if your child has tested positive for Covid-19.

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SATS Week

Children in Year 6 will be completing their SATS tests during the week commencing Monday 9th May. The children have been working extremely hard throughout the year and we are very proud of all the progress they have made.

The timetable for the tests is as follows:

Monday 9th May – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

Tuesday 10th May – Reading

Wednesday 11th May – Maths Paper 1 and 2

Thursday 12th May – Maths Paper 3

It is important that Year 6 children are in school on the above days. Results from tests will be received in July 2022 and these will be shared with parents/carers.

As the term progresses, Year 2 children will also complete their Key Stage 1 SATS, Year 1 children will complete their Phonics Screening and Year 4 children will complete a multiplication check.

Seesaw

We will continue to use the Seesaw app for parents to contact class teachers. Any enquiries related to your child's learning or general queries about the class (i.e. PE Days, reading books) should be sent through Seesaw.

Any general school queries (school dinners, school events) should be directed to the school office, via e-mail or phone. Class teachers are normally on the playground at the start/end of the school day to also answer any of your queries.

PE Days

On PE days, children in Classes 2, 3, 4 and 5 should come to school in their PE kit. Please see below a list of PE days for the Spring Term. Class 1 should bring their PE kit in a bag to get changed into.

School Dinners

Dinner menus are available on our school website under Parents > School Dinners.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the 'Universal Infant Free School Meal' Government initiative. Alternatively, parents are permitted to send their child with a packed lunch, if they wish.

For children in Nursery, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 – hot dinners will be available each day at a cost of **£2.40** per day or £12.00 per week. Payment for dinners can be made using the Parent Pay app.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

Both Breakfast Club and After School Club continue to be available during term time.

Breakfast Club is available from 7:45am until 8:55am.

- From 7:45am (including breakfast) £5.00
- From 8:00am (including breakfast) £3.00
- From 8:30am (excluding breakfast) £1.50

After School Club is available from 3:30pm until 5:00pm.

- 3:30pm – 4:00pm £2.00
- 3:30pm – 4:30pm £3.00
- 3:30pm – 5:00pm £4.50

Please ensure you have completed the booking form prior to your child attending the clubs or you have made contact with the School Office to arrange a booking.
