Dear Parents and Carers,

Class 4 Visit – 8th June 2022 – Ferens Art Gallery/Rock Up.

We are delighted to inform you that we have arranged for our Year 4 and 5 pupils to visit Rock Up and the Ferens Art Gallery in Hull. As part of our history lessons, we have been looking at railways and thought it would be really exciting for pupils to experience a train ride to Hull, before they head to the Ferens Art Gallery where there is a brick by brick international Lego display which will be amazing for the children to see. To round off the day, we will be challenging our climbing skills and communication skills at Rock up climbing and adventure centre. Pupils will undergo a full safety briefing before embarking on a climbing session.

We will travel via train from Driffield to Hull. The train will leave the Driffield train station at 9.09 a.m. ***please can we ask that parents drop pupils off at the train station at 9.00 a.m.*** this should allow enough time to drop any siblings off at Garton school before making your way to the train station. The return train will arrive back at the Driffield train station at 3.46 p.m. to again, allow enough time to collect pupils from school and then head to the train station. Please can pupils come to school dressed in **their P.E. kit along with a school jumper/cardigan and suitable footwear.**

Pupils will require a packed lunch to be provided from home, in a disposable plastic bag. If your child receives Free School meals a school packed lunch can be ordered from Middleton School kitchen, at no cost. If you require a school packed lunch please ensure you inform the office staff, via telephone or e-mail, by **Friday 27th May 2022**, at the very latest.

The full cost of the visit is £10.70 per child, which includes the cost of the transport and activities.

Under the 1996 Education Act the school requests a voluntary contribution of **£10.00**, this can be paid via the Parent Pay app. The remaining balance will be met by School Funds.

Garton on the Wolds Primary School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment





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The contribution is voluntary but the visit will only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions to make the trip possible, otherwise the trip will be cancelled and a full refund will be made. 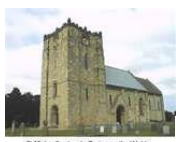
Please provide consent for your child's participation for the visit via the **Parent Pay app**. Please note children will not be permitted to take part unless parental consent is received.
