Autumn 2022 - Class One - EYFS

Our Class Topic is:

I wonder what changes...?

Throughout the term we will continue to focus on our Christian Values of:
Hope, Friendship, Respect, Tolerance, Perseverance, Forgiveness, Thankfulness

This term we shall be learning:

English	This term will be learning to read and write using our whole-school approach with the Read, Write Inc phonics scheme. Your child will be focussing on individual letters and orally blending (FS2). FS1 children will be working on listening for sounds in the environment before listening for sounds in words. Your child will also enjoy reading and mark making within the other areas of the curriculum as well as mark making using a variety of different media. We are re-introducing our message centre this term so your children may like to start writing messages to each other. We will send books home for your child. Please enjoy reading these.
Mathematics	We follow White Rose Maths across the school and this is also used in EYFS. This term, we will cover: Getting to know you Just like me! It's me 1,2,3! Light and dark The White Rose Maths scheme develops the mathematical thinking of your child so they have a strong understanding of Mathematics. Your child is taught Maths through daily adult-led sessions but is also encouraged to explore Mathematics through their play. Your child will be given Maths homework when they are ready.
Religious Education	I am special. Special to me - my home, my classroom, my favourite places. Special to all of us - classroom, school. Special to lots of people - Christian places of worship (churches) + others. The world as a special place.
Science	Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them. Use all their senses in exploration of natural materials. Explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties.

	Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary. Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice.
