Mini-beasts

**Throughout the term we will continue to focus on our Christian Values of:

This term we shall be learning:

English

We will be learning to read and write using our whole-school approach with the Read, Write Inc scheme. FS2 children will continue to read and write words/sentences at a level that is appropriate for them.
(FS1 lower) will be working on listening for sounds in the environment before listening for sounds in words.
(FS1 upper) Some children are working on recognising individual letters and orally blending and some children will be working on reading simple CVC words.
Your child will also enjoy reading and mark making and writing within the other areas of the curriculum as well as mark making and writing in a variety of different medias.
As well as the Read Write Inc scheme, we will also be encouraging more independent writing - lists/ writing about mini-beasts and instructions on how to make a bug hotel.
We will send books home as a sharing book for your child. Please enjoy reading these with your child.
Please continue to work with your child on the work which is sent home.

Mathematics

We follow the White Rose Maths across the school and this is also in EYFS via Master the Curriculum scheme.
This term, we will cover:
To 20 and beyond
First/then and now
Adding/taking away.
Composing and decomposing.

The White Rose Maths scheme develops the mathematical thinking of your child so they have a strong understanding of Mathematics. Your child is taught Maths through daily adult-led sessions but also encouraged to explore Mathematics through their play too.

Your child will be given Maths homework when they are ready.

	FS1 children will be focussing on: - Sequencing - Positional language - More than/fewer - 2d and 3d shapes
Religious Education	Special times. Special to me. Special to lots of people - this will include a mock Christening.
Science	Understanding life cycles. Understanding the differences between mini-beasts. Observing their own caterpillars turn into butterflies.
History	Toys in the past.
Geography	Understanding and looking at the weather and what weather different mini-beasts like and why. Learning about different animals and habitats around the world. Caring for animals and creatures.
Art	Observational drawing of their caterpillars/butterflies.
Design and Technology	Making a mini-beast house.
Computing	Bee bots. Internet safety.
Music	Specialist teaching with Mrs Rooke - Songs and percussion on things that grow. Coronation songs. Songs linked to the topic.
Physical Education	Gymnastics.
PSHE	Recognising our own and others emotions and what we can do when we feel like we do.
