Our Class Topic is:

This term we will focus on these areas:

English

Throughout your child's time in EYFS, Communication and Language is a vital skill which your child will develop.

We aim to provide your child with a rich, engaging environment with adults who can effectively support your child through; modelling play, holding conversations and introducing new vocabulary. We will engage in many story times using high-quality texts from stories, rhymes, songs and poems which allow your child to listen to longer stories and help them to describe events from the story.

Your child will be learning to read and write using our whole-school approach with the Read, Write Inc scheme. Your child will be focussing on individual letters and oral blending. The children will be working on listening for sounds in the environment before listening for sounds in words.

Your child will also enjoy reading and mark making within the other areas of the curriculum as well as mark making in a variety of different medias. We will send books home as a sharing book for your child. Please do take the opportunity to spend time reading these with your child.

Mathematics

The school follows the White Rose Maths scheme and within EYFS we focus on the "Master the Curriculum" section.

This term, we will cover:

Getting to know you

Just like me!

It's me 1,2,3!

Light and dark

The White Rose Maths scheme develops the mathematical thinking of your child so they have a strong understanding of Mathematics. Your child is taught Maths through daily adult-led sessions whilst also being encouraged to explore Mathematics through their play too.

Religious Education	I am special Special to me - my home, my classroom, my favourite places Special to all of us, classroom, school special to lots of people - Christian places of worship (churches) and others. The world as a special place
Science	Understand the impact of changing seasons on the natural world around them. Use all of their senses in exploration of natural materials. Explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties. Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary. Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice.
History	History is taught throughout the provision areas within the classroom along with some directed adult time. This may be through exploring different texts, comparing then and now. My own timeline Christmas then and now
Geography	Geography is taught throughout the provision areas within the classroom along with some directed adult time. This term the children will be exploring their local environment.
Art	Art is taught throughout the provision areas within the classroom along with some directed adult time. This term the children will be exploring colour mixing.
Design and Technology	Autumn - Making bread (cooking and nutrition) Mini me (mechanism)
Computing	Children have access to computing resources within their independent play however they will also be looking at Expressive Arts within Computing.
Music	Specialist teaching with Kim Rooke - Songs and percussion on things that grow. Christmas songs
Physical Education	Early Year First PE Superhero Dance
PSHE	All about me and how we feel and how our friends feel. The colour monster book. How others will feel in different situations.
